From Your
Course Superintendent
Wade Toeplitz

Every month I sit down to write my newsletter I look back at the same month in previous years. Seems things are very similar. We are facing the same challenges we had in March of every year I've been here. Poa is popping, wind is blowing, grass is greening up earlier than expected, cold weather events and a large rain fall. It is probably safe to say we will be seeing another cold weather event in the next few weeks. The last was quite extreme with snow and ice on the ground for over a week.

In the next few weeks we will be taking care of the many weeds that have showed their ugly face. The warmth and the moisture really caused us some serious outbreaks. With the forecast we have it looks like I'll be taking advantage of any day that I can. If it requires a Sunday then I'll have to make that work as well but I will get those cleaned up. Greens have still managed to stay somewhat clean with exception of a few poa clumps. Mark has continued to scope every green daily and dab with a herbicide sponge. Once weather is just right we will apply another herbicide for spring and summer weeds on the greens.

Every season I focus on adding on new cultural practices, updating the fertility program and fine tuning our insect and fungicide program to be more preventative. One thing this season is to start our fairway aeration earlier and hopefully find a way to verti-cut them as well. The plan is to not be as disruptive as possible. Although sometimes we need to be to get things back to health. This will to soften the surface up and allow for water, air and nutrients to reach the roots. Healthier roots means healthier overall turf. If we could just find a way to rid of earthworms. We are currently looking into brush attachments for the fairway unit to eliminate at least 50% of them when mowing.

Remember that high school golf is in full force here. We are scheduled for I believe 3 high school tournaments this month so please watch the calendar. My personal opinion is it's too cold for that but you still seem to see kids out in shorts. Guess they missed the weather forecast. Anyways, let's let them have their time to learn the game of golf.

Here's to another great season on The Hill!
