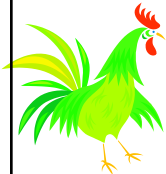

This month has been wonderful and a significant amount of progress at Webb Hill. While weather conditions have remained steady and temperatures are not yet optimal for full growth, this is typical for the season and rapid growth should not be expected for a few more weeks. Remember the 150 rule. When the night time temps and day time temps equal 150, growth should be in full force. Things really start to happen then.

Despite temperature fluctuations, we are well ahead of schedule. Tees and fairways have already undergone verticutting, which is essential for long-term turf health. Both areas have also been aerated twice with the Aerway system to reduce compaction; this will continue as a routine practice throughout the season. Greens have received solid tine aerification, with another solid tine planned for early next month during course closure. Please understand that when maintenance requires closure, it applies to the entire course. This approach, common among golf courses, is necessary to ensure optimal playing conditions. While closures can be inconvenient, they are crucial to maintaining high standards and consistent quality.

Currently, the greens are looking great for this time of year and have received positive feedback. However, their ongoing care remains a priority, as they are central to the course's quality. Maintaining greens demands constant attention, almost like caring for ourselves. These challenges are the same at all courses, and I encourage everyone to bear this in mind when visiting other courses.

Also, we are happy to be opening Webb Hills pool for the season this month. This facility, like others, requires rigorous maintenance and dedication. We look forward to welcoming swimmers and continuing its tradition as an attraction for all communities nearby. I certainly have fond memories hanging out at the pool as a kid and young teen. I know my kids as well as ready.

On behalf of Webb Hill, I extend my gratitude to all members and guests for your continued support. Our team is committed to delivering excellent service and appreciates your understanding regarding the efforts required to maintain our county club.

2026 Pool Opening!

Our swimming pool will open Saturday, May 23rd. The pool will be open each Tuesday through Saturday from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. daily and Sundays from 1:00 until 7:00. The pool is closed on Mondays. There is **NO lifeguard** on duty.

Swimming Pool Rules:

For your safety and enjoyment, please obey the following established pool rules:

1. All persons-members and guests-in bathing suits, must register in the golf shop.
2. Any persons who are not members or members of the immediate family shall be considered guests. All member's guests must be registered.
3. Guest fees are \$5.00.
4. There will be no swimming except during regular pool hours.
5. There will be no large or dangerous objects allowed in the pool at anytime.
6. No glass is permitted in the pool area.
7. Rough play and running are not permitted in or out of the pool.
8. Children 10 years of age and under are not allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult.
