## Superintendent's Notes

I almost feel like I should state the same thing as last newsletter. Weather has been the same since then. Just when you think it's about to take off it gets cool again. I do know that my peers in the business are having the same issues. Nothing is taking off exactly like we want. We're all the same when I say we live for the golf season. Heat and sunlight is our friend. We can't wait for this course to take off.

Even though we still aren't where we'd like to be, I feel we have been on top of things to the best of our abilities. This time of year is especially a challenge for us. Moisture and rain can be a blessing and a curse. The course needs the rain but it certainly causes issues when you have 100 plus acres to mow. There's just sometimes we can't get it knocked out. I'm sure it's an issue for golfers but I promise you it affects us more than anyone. We literally can't start mowing tees or fairways till it's completely dry due to worm castings. By then, golfers are everywhere. In a way that's not a bad thing. There are plans for this issue but may still be some time out. Earthworms are very beneficial but equally disruptive.

We do our best to give a notice when we are going to do anything that can disturb the playing surface but recently I made a quick decision to verti-cut and topdress greens on a Monday. A decision made to try and beat the 10 day rain forecast. I know that wasn't ideal for golfers that day, and I promise you it wasn't for us either. 14 hours later that process was complete. You'll thank me in the weeks to come. The plan for the season is a light verti-cutting or grooming and a dust of sand every 2 to 4 weeks. By the time this newsletter reaches membership the first core aeration should be complete and not another core aeration planned till late summer. Unless weather doesn't permit of course. There will be several solid tine aerifications in between. Way more beneficial than most have any idea. I've monitored our greens structure since I began and can say the black layer has improved tremendously! This is due to the frequent cultural practices we perform,

Outside the course, the pool looks amazing! Best I've seen in seasons. Yes, maintenance takes care of the pool and we take pride in it. Please come and enjoy with the family and friends. We've been preparing for weeks for opening day.
