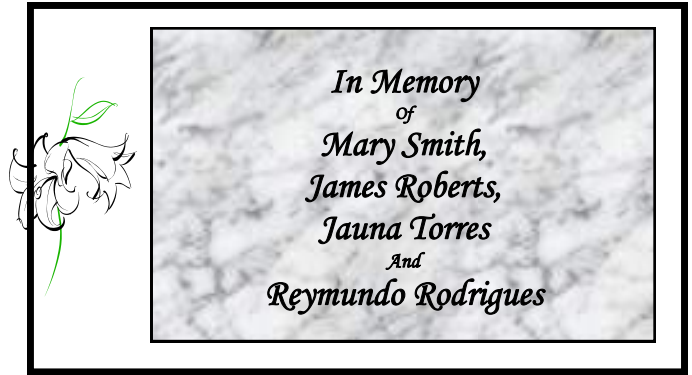

June was certainly tough on us but rewarding as well. We have truly spent more time at the course preparing than at home. Might even be true for the last 5 years. It's been great watching the course come around. Just the other day I was looking through pictures of conditions the week I began. That winter really put a hurt on the course and irrigation system. So much that there are still areas affected by it and some new to prove mother nature is always in control. The rain has been typical this month by causing us to get in and get things done when we can. Yes, that means till early morning or late night. More is forecasted for the whole week so we are hoping the weather man is wrong. At the moment his prediction was wrong and we are rained out for the day.

This month is business as usual. Nothing major planned to disturb play, but if I see the need and have the opportunity, we may do some solid tine aerifications followed by a dusting of sand. Way less disruptive than pulling cores and a heavy sanding. We try to only do 2 of those a season. Best answer to how often should you aerate is as often as you can. We did recently install sod on a few fairways to fix large bare spots or washes. Doing a little at a time with plans to do more. Looking forward to seeing our fairways lush and smooth. Still lots of growing season ahead of us to promote growth and repair those troublesome areas.

Still battling those earthworm castings! Trust me when I say that we know they're a problem. In more ways than you know. Recently we've engineered a few drag mats to at least try to knock them down. Nothing great but it's a start. Hope to have something really dialed in in the next few weeks.
