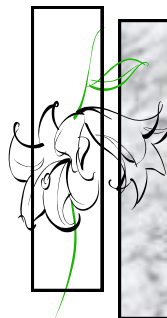

Superintendent's Notes

.....From Wade Toeplitz

I can't say this has been the best of months here at Webb Hill. Not sure how many days we've reached over 100 degrees but the forecast is showing the same for the next two weeks. The anticipation for cooler weather is very high amongst us. Regardless of the relentless heat the crew has continued to push on and work towards making Webb Hill great. Maybe times like these being the pool guy isn't so bad.

The course has held up better than I expected. Even after 4 days of no running water for the course. But after some substantial pump repairs we are up and operating normally. I've always said that during these times if you miss one day of irrigation it sets you back two. So we are doing our best to catch up and conserve water at the same time. We do have the well water running but a good evening of heavy watering takes out more than can be replenished before the next watering cycle. Not to mention that the water comes out very high in salts that can cause issues for our turf. Which is why we are always out watering with a hose to try and soak the localized dry spots or areas that are hard to reach.

By this time we are hoping to have our second core aerification done on the greens. I do anticipate the holes to recover quickly and we be looking and rolling great before the tournaments are scheduled. We try several different tines and spacing on the greens throughout the season. This time we are focusing on going deeper with a wider core diameter but spaced further apart so we don't interrupt roll too much. Sorry for the inconvenience but it is one of the single most important processes we do to maintain the health of our greens. Doing several aerifications per year has shown a great improvement in our greens structure. In the future, my goal is to get some videos of this process to post for our members.

Don't forget the end of the pool season is coming. I do believe everyone was happy with it this year. In my opinion it was better than any season I can remember. If the heat continues on this path maybe we can convince someone to keep it open a little longer. I can't thank Mark enough for his help with the pool. This winter we would really like to plan on improving our structures for shade and maybe the addition of more as well.
